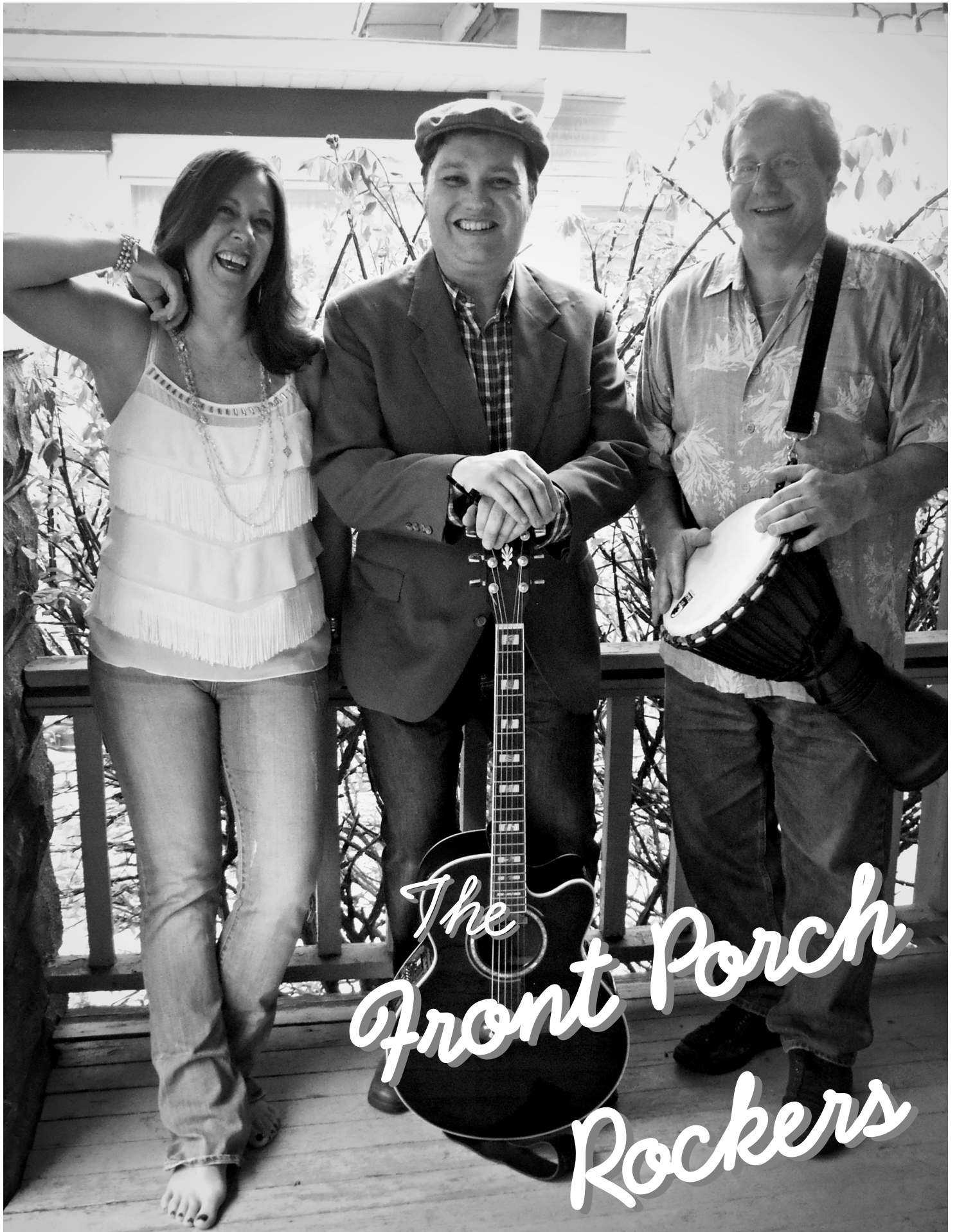
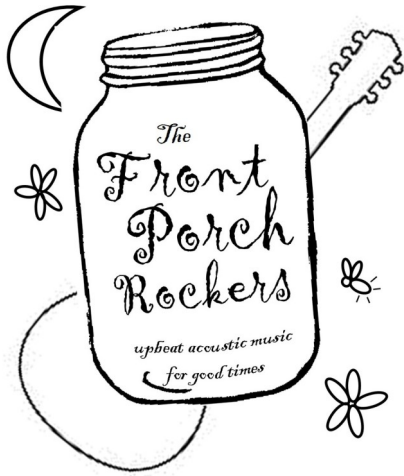

**Paula Treacy (vocals, shakers)** has been performing professionally for over a decade. She also sings with the rock band Scattered.

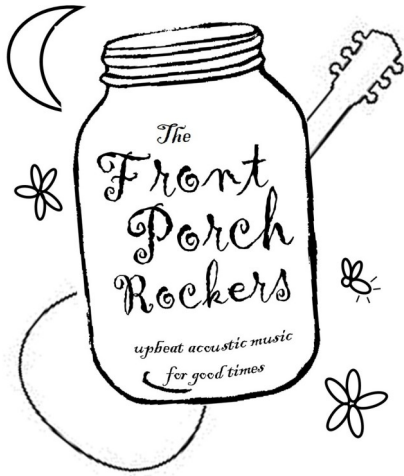


**Jim Richards (percussion)** has been playing percussion for over four decades, including with several local blues bands.

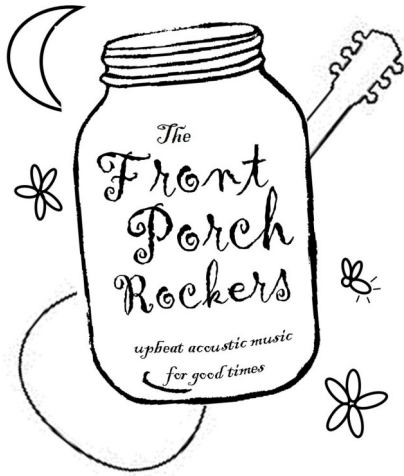
